*News and thanks from Beira:* Your generosity is helping farmers to water parched land, triple harvests and ensure families in drought stricken parts of Ethiopia grow enough food to eat and sell. 'Farming on my own wasn't getting me anywhere' says 62yr old Alemayo. 'Now the whole village is involved we can make a big impact. We want to maximise profits by improving access to and from the village. A better road would help us transport goods to market by car instead of by foot'.

*Wonderful news re Cafod Water Appeal in Lent:* This has now reached over £9m with matched funding to come from the Government. The aim of the original project was £2m so many more communities can now be given clean water. Grateful thanks to everyone who supported the Appeal.
