DAY FOR LIFE

The human body is an extraordinary gift, an amazingly wonderful and complicated organism that we take for granted until it ceases to function well through illness or some traumatic injury. This year 'Day for Life' recognises the marvellous achievements of the human body in events such as the Olympic and Paralympic games being held in London this year. It highlights the importance of good health, the care of our body and the importance of exercise and sporting activity. Pope Benedict XVI sees such activity as "a training ground of healthy competition and physical improvement, a school of formation in the human and spiritual values, a privileged means of personal growth and contact with society". 'Day for Life' invites us therefore to show respect for the dignity of our body in every moment of its existence, from conception to natural death. There will be a retiring collection for 'Day for Life' after all masses this weekend, **28th/29th July** - the proceeds of this collection will assist the work of the Anscombe Bioethics Centre and other life-related activities supported by the Church.
