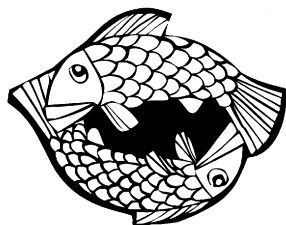

#### MONSIGNOR MARK O'TOOLE'S ORDINATION

Monsignor Mark O'Toole will be ordained as Bishop of the Diocese of Plymouth this **Tuesday 28th January at 2pm** in Plymouth Cathedral. Please pray for him as he prepares, as bishop, to answer our Lord's call to 'Feed my lambs, look after my sheep'.

Because of the great number of people invited to the Ordination, only those who have been allocated tickets are able to go to the service but it is being broadcast via the internet for parishioners who wish to be present 'in spirit' if not in body! To acquaint you with the less familiar actions which take place during a Bishop's ordination, the diocese has produced a booklet 'This Fragrant Offering' which is available in the Narthex. There will also be a live broadcast of Solemn Vespers from the Cathedral on the eve of the ordination at 6.00pm on Monday 27th January, the broadcast commencing at 5.30pm. Please note that there will be no Mass at 7.00pm at St. Augustine's on 28th January.
