### **EXHIBITION OF THE LIFE AND WORKS OF ST. TERESA OF AVILA 1515-2015**

As part of the celebration of the 500th Anniversary of the birth of St. Teresa of Avila, this exhibition will be in Plymouth Cathedral until **Wednesday 15th October**.
