Please return your old palm crosses and place them in the basket in the Narthex. These will be burnt for the ashes used on **Ash Wednesday**.

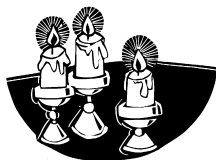
## **DIOCESAN RESIDENTIAL RETREATS**
