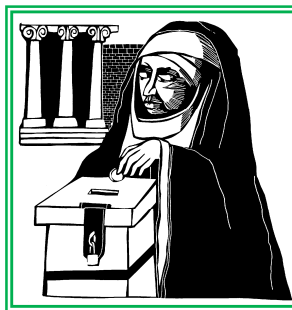

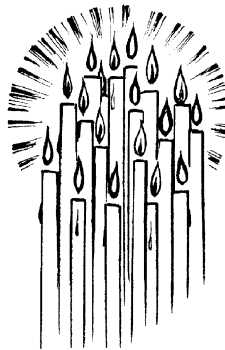
#### CATHOLIC WOMEN'S LEAGUE - Tuesday 17th

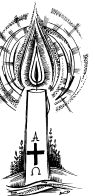
