### **DIOCESAN PILGRIMAGE TO CREDITON**

#### ***Sunday 5th June: Solemnity of St. Boniface***

After prayers at the statue there will be a final blessing by Bishop Mark, returning to St Boniface Church for afternoon tea. The town is also celebrating with a Flower Festival at Holy Cross Church, a St Boniface Walk commencing at 2pm and a re-enactment of the story of St Boniface below the statue in Newcombes Meadow at 3pm.
