WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS

On *Sunday 7th May* the Church celebrates the call to the priesthood and consecrated life. On this one Sunday we pray especially for those God is calling to be consecrated or to be ordained as priests and deacons. The people God calls to these ways of life are people who put the extra into ordinary. Priests and religious are not extraordinary, they are ordinary people called to make visible the extra dimensions of ordinary life.
