NARTHEX ALTERATIONS AND REDECORATION

During August, there will be some work taking place to improve the Narthex of the church. This is planned to commence on **Monday 21st August**. It will include the installation of 3 roof lights, new lighting, redecoration and the installation of acoustic panels to improve the acoustic of the area.

It is expected that the total cost of the work will be between £20,000 and £24,000. Although this is a lot to spend, the Narthex is an important area of the church building. Not only is it the entrance area to the church but also it is used for meetings and social activities.

This work will take about 3 weeks and will affect the use of the church. During the week, the Narthex will be out of use, except if funerals need to take place. Weekday Masses will take place in the St. Cuthbert Mayne room, access to which will be via the memorial garden. At the weekends, the Narthex will be brought back into use and Masses will take place as normal in the main church.

Although this will cause some disruption, it is a much needed improvement and redecoration of this area.
