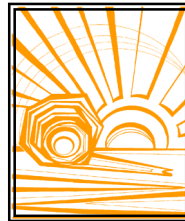

EASTER OFFERINGS

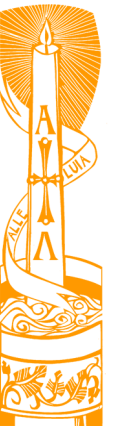
