## **NATIONAL EUCHARISTIC PILGRIMAGE & CONGRESS (Adoremus)**

### ***'I am the Bread of Life' in Liverpool, 7th-9th September 2018***

The Catholic Bishop's Conference of England and Wales is holding the first Eucharistic Congress since 1908. The focus of the Congress is Eucharistic Adoration. Because Adoration of the Eucharist deepens our relationship with Christ, it enables us to be more effective disciples who will be better able to lead others to the life of the Church that has the Eucharist at its heart. The main part of the event will take place at the Liverpool Echo Arena on Saturday 8th September and each Diocese has a number of places reserved for this. St Augustine's has been allocated 3 delegate places. If you would like to represent St Augustine's at this historic Congress please let Fr Peter know by the end of March. The cost of a place is £40 per delegate per day. A financial contribution from the parish towards the cost of the weekend will be available if needed.

## **DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION CONSULTATION ON "CHANGES TO THE TEACHING OF SEX & RELATIONSHIP EDUCATION"**

The Children and Social Work Act 2017 made Relationship Education a compulsory school subject in all primary schools, and Relationship and Sex Education a compulsory subject in all secondary schools. The rationale is to introduce the idea of diversity of relationships at an early age. The Government has launched a consultation on what should be taught in these new compulsory subjects. It is proposed that children will be taught that same sex relationships are as valid as marriage between a man and a woman. There will be scope to introduce gender issues, with children encouraged to question their gender and the very idea of there being two distinct sexes. Sex Education is an ideological battle ground. All concerned citizens, especially parents, grandparents and those working professionally in schools are encouraged to take part in this consultation which closes at ***11.45pm on Monday 12th February 2018***.
