## **NATIONAL EUCHARISTIC PILGRIMAGE & CONGRESS (Adoremus)**

**'I am the Bread of Life' in Liverpool, 7th-9th September 2018**

The Catholic Bishop's Conference of England and Wales is holding the first Eucharistic Congress since 1908. The focus of the Congress is Eucharistic Adoration. Because Adoration of the Eucharist deepens our relationship with Christ, it enables us to be more effective disciples who will be better able to lead others to the life of the Church that has the Eucharist at its heart. The main part of the event will take place at the Liverpool Echo Arena on Saturday 8th September and each Diocese has a number of places reserved for this. St Augustine's has been allocated 3 delegate places. If you would like to be considered to represent St Augustine's at this historic Congress please let Fr Peter know by the end of March. The cost of a place is £40 per delegate per day. A financial contribution from the parish towards the cost of the weekend will be available if needed.
