

7. REPAIRS & MAINTENANCE

- **Heating:** The Heating Committee is continuing to make progress in its research of the best solution to replacing the church's heating system. Ann mentioned that the Apostleship of the Sea had collected £50.00 for the heating fund. George reported that the forthcoming Mevagissey Choir Concert in June was specifically to raise funds for the heating system. Tom Regan reassured the PCG that all money donated for a specific purpose is clearly designated and recorded in the Parish Accounting system.
- **Outside Maintenance:** The quotation for the outside decoration and maintenance of the church and presbytery has been accepted and work will start as soon as the weather improves.
- **Organ Maintenance:** A quotation for the complete overhaul of the organ has been received from Copeman Hart. This is being given to Paul Mileham so that he can advise on what work is necessary. The CWL have already given a donation to the Parish for this purpose.

9. SOCIAL GROUP REPORT
